About the Seminar:

The existence of knowledge is unanimously accepted, because without knowledge no usage, be it acceptance or rejection or avoidance is possible. But how do we know? What are the conditions for acquiring Knowledge? What are the sources of Knowledge? How far can we know? Which knowledge is valid and which is invalid? Does genuine knowledge require justification or evidence? Is there a difference between knowledge and true belief, and if so, what is it? All these questions are dealt with by Epistemology, a major branch of Philosophy. In a word, Epistemology is called theory of knowledge. Some important Epistemological theories include: Rationalism, Empiricism etc.

Metaphysics, the other major branch of Philosophy, is concerned with the questions like: What is the nature of reality? Does the world exist outside the mind? How does the world exist and what is its origin or source of creation? How does mind affect the body? What is the objective nature of thing? Does God exist? etc. Metaphysics is believed to be the foundation of Philosophy because the origin of Philosophy was Metaphysical in nature. However, history

shows that Metaphysics has been attacked at many times. Sometimes it is said that Metaphysics is futile and vague. Especially very often we find Metaphysical ideas and concepts are in conflict with modern science. But, recently even as Metaphysics has been criticised for its apparent lack of access to the true nature of ultimate reality, so has science started to have its own difficulties in claiming absolute knowledge. Herein, lies the importance of studying Metaphysics.
